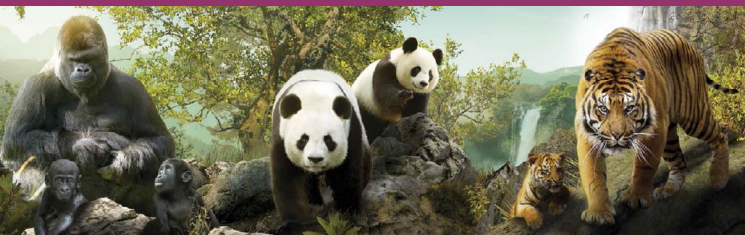

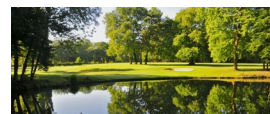

CHÂTEAU DE CHAMBORD

Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1981, Chambord is the emblem of the French Renaissance for visitors from around the world. The Château also boasts the largest enclosed nature reserve in Europe, including 5,440 hectares of forest, and offers numerous outdoor activities. Brush shoulders with 500 years of history in this showpiece of architecture and nature located less than an hour from Orléans.

BLOIS ROYAL CHÂTEAU

A royal favourite! During the Renaissance, the Royal Château of Blois was the preferred residence of French sovereigns. Today, it provides visitors with a sweeping panorama of Châteaux de la Loire architecture and history. Don't miss the 45-min sound & light show whose special effects and larger-than-life projections bring the courtyard's grandiose architecture to life.

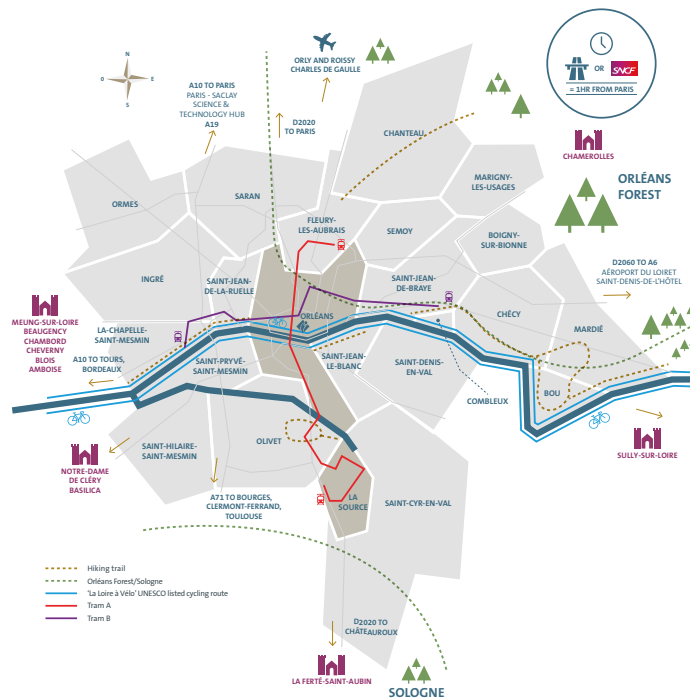
AMBOISE ROYAL CHÂTEAU

The original, imposing medieval fortress was made over into a luxurious royal residence under the reigns of French Kings Charles VIII and François Ist. Stroll through its panoramic gardens overlooking the Loire, and dream of days gone by.

CHÂTEAU DE CHAMEROLLES

Discover one of the few perfume museums in France! This château retraces the history of hygiene and the use of perfumes from the 16th century to present day. Other highlights include the protestant chapel and a lovely Renaissance garden.

CHÂTEAU DE BEAUGENCY

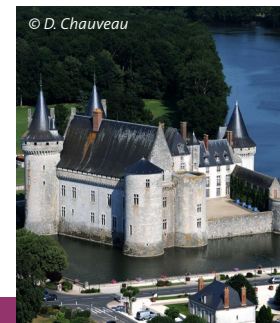
A fine example of a feudal lord's castle, the original owner, Jean de Dunois, the Bastard of Orléans, was succeeded by the Lords of Beaugency, the French crown, and the Dukes of Orléans in the 14th century.

CHÂTEAU DE MEUNG-SUR-LOIRE

One of the largest and oldest castles in the Loiret department, the Château was owned by the bishops of Orléans until the French Revolution. A short drive from Orléans, the castle offers 20 furnished rooms, from 18th century kitchens to bathrooms, and displays over 2,000 objects.

CHÂTEAU DE SULLY-SUR-LOIRE

This château was built as a fortified monument to defend the bridge across the Loire, as well as a showpiece for sumptuous receptions.

A smaller château was added on several decades later to house the Lord of the castle and his family.

LA FERTÉ-SAINT-AUBIN

Visit its 40-hectare park with games and activities for all ages, 15 furnished rooms and antique toy exhibit. The castle cook even prepares delicious honey madeleines to sample on Sundays and during school holidays.

CHÂTEAU DE CHEVERNY

Lived in by the same family for 600 years, this was the first Loire valley château to open its doors to the public, in 1922. Today, you can experience the splendour of real castle life, from the magnificent interior to its 4 themed gardens, kennels filled with hunting dogs and wooded grounds. A permanent, interactive Tintin exhibit rounds out the visit.
