



### 01 Museum of fine arts

It was founded in the 18<sup>th</sup> century and boasts over 700 works of arts from the 15<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup> century, making it one of the oldest and most diverse French museums. Paintings, drawings, engravings, sculptures, works of art... you will be overwhelmed! The Cabinet des pastels, a flagship in the collections, is a splendid display of major works from the 18<sup>th</sup> century.

Adult fee: €6 The "Musées d'Orleans" bundle ticket

is valid for 1 day and also gives access to the 3 following museums.

# 02 Joan of Arc's House

The half-timbered house, which was rebuilt identically to the residence of Jacques Boucher, Treasurer General of the Duke of Orleans, who accommodated Joan of Arc during the siege of Orleans in 1429, offers visitors a multime-

dia immersion charting the Hundred Years' War and the history of Joan of Arc. The first floor boasts an incredible document library about the Middle Ages.

# 03 Hotel Cabu - Museum of history and archaeology

The museum, which is located in Hôtel Cabu, one of the city's finest Renaissance monuments, holds the treasure of Neuvy-en-Sullias, an exceptional set of Gallic and Gallo-Roman bronzes. It features a room dedicated to Joan of Arc, with a chronological itinerary.

# 06 CERCIL - Memorial Museum for the children of the Vel d'Hiv

The Memorial Museum, a re-

search centre on Jewish deportation and on the history of the internment camps of Jargeau, Beaune-la-Rolande and Pithiviers, includes a museographical circuit retracing the history of detainees in the three camps.

# 07 Collégiale Saint-Pierre-le-Puellier

The Saint-Pierre-le-Puellier Cloister, a former Romanesque church, was desacralised in 1958. Today it hosts ephemeral contemporary art exhibitions. It dates back to the 12<sup>th</sup> century and is the oldest preserved church in Orleans.

Orleans boasts 4 national labels in performing arts: Scène nationale (National Scene), CDN (centre dramatique national, National Drama Centre), CCN (centre chorégraphique national, National Choreography Centre), and SMAC (scène de musiques actuelles, Current Music Scene).

The Théâtre d'Orleans is home to the CADO, which enables artists to create and perform 6 shows every season.

The century-old Orleans symphonic orchestra offers a dozen concerts every year in an exciting, varied repertoire. An association called "la Fabrique Opéra Val de Loire" introduces a new show every year, and offers a universal, popular opera.
